WHAT IS THE STATUS OF THE PLANNING RULE?

From April 2010 thru May 2010, the Forest Service conducted a Collaborative process where it sought comments from Tribes, counties, and the general public. These comments were received in writing, Online, and at various forums held throughout the Nation. All of the reports are available at www.idrsinc.org/forestplanningportal

Between May 2010 and August 9, 2010. Forest Service drafted concept papers, outlining the direction of the New Rule. Those documents are available at the [www.idrsinc.org/Forest planning web post](http://www.idrsinc.org/Forest%20planning%20web%20post) (<http://www.idrsinc.org/?p=738>)

Between July 29, 2010 to August 5, 2010. Forest Service held the 4th National Round Table to review concepts with the Public and on August 5, 2010 National Tribal Conference Call to review concepts with Tribes.

The Rule Drafting Team is currently working on the Draft Planning Rule and Draft EIS based on the reports and comments received to date.

WHAT'S NEXT?

August 2010 to November 2010

- Rule Drafting Phase- taking public and tribal forum comments to synthesize Draft Rule.

December 2010 -- January 2011

- Publication of Draft Rule expected, Notice and comment phase begins (runs for 60 Days).
- Government to Government Consultation with local National Forest Representatives. (Deadline: Feb. 2011)

January 2011 – February 2011

- Additional Regional and National Public and Tribal Roundtables anticipated.
